## Genius EcoZone Sprinkler 2.0 Addressing

## Connect & address each sprinkler one at a time.

- 1. Connect Server Cable leads to Server terminals: Red: Eco 1-8, White: EcoZone Common
- 2. Mobile App: Server Page Click on "EcoZones 1-8" and select "Genius Sprinkler" for all of the EcoZones needed for the installation
- 3. Connect Server Cable only to the 1<sup>st</sup> Sprinkler. (Save End Plug for last Sprinkler in line)
- 4. Go to Zone page, select EcoZone Sprinkler number "1"
- 5. Select "NO" to Calibration select "YES" to Programming app will run a 30 second countdown, wait for it to finish (or wait for Sprinkler to stop turning).
- 6. Click on upper right menu icon, select "Exit" to exits zone and addresses that sprinkler)
- 7. That Sprinkler is now addressed as "Sprinkler #1"
- 8. Connect <u>only the next Sprinkler in line</u> with a Sprinkler Cable and repeat Steps 4-8, <u>making sure to select the next EcoZone number in Step 4.</u> Repeat until all Sprinklers are uniquely addressed. Connect only one unaddressed Sprinkler at a time. Connecting more than one unaddressed sprinkler at a time will produce a "Wiring Error" message.
- 9. Install CableLok to secure all cable connections (See CableLok diagram)

For more than eight EcoZones: For EcoZones 9-16 – Connect a second Server Cable to Server terminals: Red: Eco 9-16, White: EcoZone Common. Do Steps 2-9; except for Step 2 click on "EcoZones 9-16", and for Step 4 select EcoZone "9".

## **Troubleshooting "Wiring Error" message:**

- A. Make sure all Plug n Play connectors are correctly aligned and fully pushed together
- B. Check if more than one unaddressed Sprinkler is connected at a time. Unplug all unaddressed sprinklers except for one
- C. **Two Sprinklers have the same address.** Connect only one of them, go Zone page, top right menu icon, select "Erase Zone" to erase the address. Repeat Step 8 with correct address.
  - Only trench Cables or pull another 1" pipe as conduit. Don't pull EcoZone cables
  - Cables should not be cut and spliced loop excess cable around head or in trench.
  - **To branch out your Sprinklers** use Plug-n-Play Cable Tee; use End Plug for last Sprinkler in branched line. Always use a CableLok. **Tees do not affect addresses.**
